Visaya Hoffie is an artist based in Australia who graduated with a Bachelor of Fine Art at Queensland College of Art, Griffith University. Trained as a painter, she also engages a range of different media including sculpture, printmaking, textiles, assemblage, inflatables, zines and animation. Her work addresses themes raised by the impact of social media on the everyday. She draws from popular culture and the cultural histories of outsiders and 'Others' to explore the possibilities of magic, ritual, re-enchantment and critical cultural re-evaluations that engage with crucial contemporary issues while maintaining one foot in radical playfulness.

She has received a number of awards and opportunities to exhibit in galleries across Australia, and has travelled throughout the Asia-Pacific, the US, Europe and the UK. During time spent in London in 2018, she worked at leading UK institutions including the V&A Museum; the Museum of Everything, and at the FriezeMasters Art Fair and 1-54 Contemporary African Art Fair. She has worked at the Queensland Art Gallery and Gallery of Modern Art and tutors in the Painting Department at QCAD, Griffith University. Her prolific exhibition practice has progressed through a range of visual arts projects in Australia and overseas. Visaya's art practice challenges traditional genres and processes of production, incorporating new audiences and sites through incorporating fashion, music and design in inclusive and site-specific ways.
